DATA PROTECTION AND THE NEW GDPR

The data protection landscape is changing. Early next year the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) will come into force. It contains a large number of changes to the current data protection legislation, and now is the time to start preparing. The government has stated that all EU law will be incorporated into post-Brexit UK’s statute books, and fines for breaches of the data protection rules are set to rise to 20,000,000 Euros or 4% of global turnover, whichever is higher.
